Current Campaign-Children's Ministry Building

This 28k sq. ft. building was dedicated on December 4th, 2016. The building expanded the opportunity to serve our children and families. Our Creative Learning Center also benefited with full day options and an after-school program. The building costs were \$9,114,883. As of June 30th, 2019, 240 families have gifted \$4,819,897. Thanks to our members that continue to gift and pledge, we remain on schedule to paying down the outstanding balance which is currently \$4,294,986.

Established Endowments...

Established endowments have been generated through the generosity of current and former members and the vote of the congregation. The corpus of the endowment continues for the duration of the endowments with portions of the income used regularly to support the established cause. The endowments are managed by the Trustees and the Financial Committee

- ◆ **GENERAL ENDOWMENT** is used to help with the cost of general maintenance of the physical facilities when unexpected needs arise over and budgeted items. It may also be used to pay down major indebtedness as the church decides.
- ◆ **MISSION ENDOWMENT** provides funding for mission projects not funded through the annual budget under the supervision of the Mission Council. Funds may be used to assist individual participants of to fund the projects.
- ◆ **RICHARDSON ENDOWMENT** has been established to help defray the cost the youth and their leaders as they engage in mission projects or go on mission trips.
- ◆ **SUPPLEMENTAL RETIREMENT TRUST** is used to supplement the retirement funds of ordained ministers and their spouse who have served on the staff of the congregation for more than 20 years.
- ◆ **SPENCE NETWORK** established to assist in funding the Spence Network, an organization sponsored by the Virginia Baptist Mission Board, to help young ministers in establishing their work and service in Virginia
