

COVID-19 RESPONSE ANNOUNCEMENT:
SMALL GROUP MEETINGS AT SECOND BAPTIST CHURCH

Beginning Monday, October 19, small groups of 20 or less church members may meet onsite at Second Baptist for the purposes of Bible study or prayer according to the following requirements.

Location: Small Group Meetings may be held in Spence Hall.

Timing: Spence Hall Small Group Meetings may take place Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Limitation of One Meeting Per Day: Given the cleaning requirements following such meetings, there can be only one (1) Small Group Meeting per day in Spence Hall.

Reservation Required: Groups must reserve Spence Hall meeting times with our church Administrative Secretary Patty Dimowski (extension 1145).

Duration of Meetings: The meetings will last no longer than an hour.

Access to Spence Hall: Our church Office Manager, Kathy Driver, will meet the Small Group upon their arrival and unlock Spence Hall. Kathy will also remind the Small Group of the safety protocols to be observed during the meeting. One person in the group will be designated “Facilitator” and will ensure that the group follows the safety protocols for the health of all who participate.

Mandatory Safety Protocols for Small Group Meetings in Spence Hall:

- At all times, every member of the group must wear a mask that covers the nose and mouth. Face shields are not an acceptable substitute for a mask (although face shields can be worn in addition to a face mask).

- No more than one (1) person in the Spence Hall restroom at a time.
- Chairs will be set up 6 to 8 feet apart and should not be moved.
- No food allowed at Spence Hall Small Group Meetings.
- No sound equipment (microphones) will be provided.
- No handouts or materials will be distributed on site (so as to avoid multiple people touching the same object).
