

Easter Worship on the Lawn: Frequently Asked Questions

Where will the service take place? It will take place on the lawn in the sanctuary courtyard.

What should I wear? Please wear whatever will help you worship in the outdoor setting, whether it is “business casual” attire, jeans and a polo, a suit and tie, or festive Easter dress.

Will there be congregational singing? Yes! We will be joyfully singing 3 hymns (2 stanzas each) while social distancing and wearing masks.

What style will the music be? Taylor Vancil and Hilliary Larsen will lead the singing. Instruments will include keyboard and guitar.

How long will the service last? It will last approximately 30 minutes.

Who is preaching? Pastor Noel Schoonmaker will deliver a 12 to 15-minute message. The sermon will be different than the sermon he preaches in the online Easter services.

What will I sit on? Please bring your own chair(s) or a blanket for comfortable seating. All who have reservations will have a well-marked space where you can place your chair or blanket.

What about restrooms? Please use the restroom at home before coming to the service. We do not plan to have restrooms open on campus since the services are brief and outdoors.

Where can I park? You can park in any of the parking lots **except** for the circle in front of the sanctuary courtyard.

What if it rains? If it rains on Easter afternoon, we will cancel the services.

Will there be childcare? We will not have childcare. We encourage parents to worship with their children in this brief outdoor service.

Will the in-person Easter services be livestreamed? They will not be livestreamed.
